

CONTAINER GARDENING BY LEON



1 Drill a drain hole approximately size of your pinky 3 to 4 inches from bottom, ensure hole is lower than top of milk jugs



6 Use potting mix not soil, as soil is too heavy

2 Drill 4 holes on top and bottom of milk jug 1/8 to 3/16 in size



7 Spread around until milk jugs are covered with potting mix



3 Drill holes on top and bottom of the coke bottles along the sides as well. The center will be used as the water wicking area

7 Add the below mix Or use your own fertilizer mix as desired

1/2 cup of sustain or chicken poop
1/4 cup of sea mineral NOT SALT, as salt will burn the plants
1/8 cup of epsom salt
1/8 cup of lime
1/8 cup of gypsum



4 Cut 1 inch pvc pipe at a 45 degree angle



8 Fill remainder of tub with potting mix and place plant in the middle of the tub to ensure root growth to the wicking area



5 After aerating, fertilize and water the lawn to support new growth.

9 Water from top for 2 to 3 weeks every other day as needed. then water using PVC pipe there after
